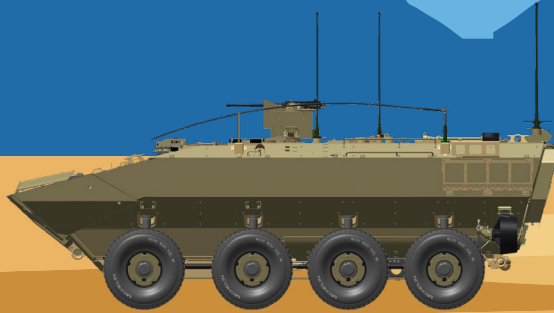


ACV Family of Vehicles

Amphibious Combat Vehicle

Personnel (ACV-P)

Designed to replace the Assault Amphibious Vehicle, the ACV-P is the primary means of tactical mobility for the Marine infantry battalion from ship-to-objective and back.



Command (ACV-C)

Provides multiple workstations and networks for Marines to maintain and manage situational awareness in the battlespace.



30mm Cannon (ACV-30)

Mounts a stabilized, 30mm Medium Caliber Cannon weapon system to provide the lethality and protection the Marines need while leaving ample room for troop capacity and payload.



Recovery (ACV-R)

Provides field maintenance, recovery and repair capabilities to the Assault Amphibian companies and battalion.



What's next?

The ACV represents the optimum balance of sea and land mobility, survivability and future growth potential. The ACV platform was designed to grow and adapt to mission needs, allowing space for new capabilities as technology evolves such as an Advanced Reconnaissance Vehicle, electronic warfare, anti-air, precision fires, naval strike, logistics and UAS systems integration.
