

Update from BAE Systems – Dargavel Village, June 2020

Welcome to our June update on Dargavel Village. This month, we are looking to restart construction work at Dargavel Village in line with Government-issued COVID-19 guidance.

- On 21 May 2020, a route map for the phased restart of construction works was agreed between the Scottish Government and Construction Scotland. Following endorsement of the first phase of this route map from the Scottish Government on 28 May 2020, we intend to recommence our on-site presence on the Dargavel Village development.
- From Monday 1 June 2020, a small number of the Bishopton programme, who are essential in preparing the site for work to restart, will be present on site.
- We have prepared detailed plans and implemented additional measures in accordance with the Government-issued guidance in order to keep our employees safe and manage the health and welfare risks of COVID-19.
- Further consultation between Scottish Government and Construction Leadership Forum members is expected over the next two weeks and we anticipate that the construction industry will then be able to move to the next phase of the route map, enabling construction work to recommence from mid-June 2020.
- When work restarts, our focus will be primarily on areas away from the public, with the exception of essential maintenance works on the development to the strategic infrastructure or areas of public open space. During this time, we may need to temporarily close some footpaths and areas to ensure we can follow social distancing guidelines.
