Superior Comfort and Design

The SMC 3000 improves comfort and bolstering for rough terrain and long duration missions and is integrated with a 5-point restraint using a single-point rotary release buckle for rapid exit. Available in multiple base options, the seat is offered with fore aft adjustment, blastworthy vertical adjustment or with a fixed height base. The SMC 3000 is qualified for the Family of Medium Tactical Vehicles (FMTV), but can be adapted to numerous vehicle configurations.

During initial blast and slam-down events, this self-resetting, energy-absorbing seat offers maximum occupant protection. The quick-release headrest and optional fold-over seat back of the SMC 3000 aids in egress during emergency evacuation.

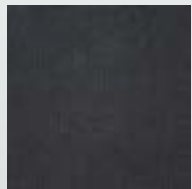

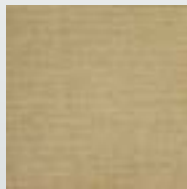

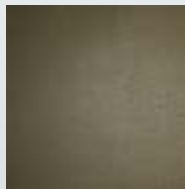
